

Polyglots Language Immersion Day Camp

Safety Guidelines for 2022

The following protocols have been created based on AHS January 2022 guidelines. Changes may be made to follow the most current AHS guidelines when they are available.

1. Practices that encourage spacing will occur.
 - a. We will spend as much time as possible outside (weather permitting).
 - b. Some supplies such as pencils, crayons, scissors we will ask to come from home.
 - c. During drop off and pick up times, we ask parents/guardians to respect the 2 metre rule.
 - d. Parents/guardians may walk their child to the door, but we request that they do not enter the room to help maintain distance.
2. Programs will operate in groups of 9 people (1 staff and 8 children).
3. Staff will instruct and help children practice excellent hand hygiene. Hands are to be washed or sanitized regularly, particularly before and after activities and eating.
4. Staff will frequently clean surfaces and common touch areas such as door handles and faucets.
5. Equipment will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized prior to reuse at the end of each week.
6. Staff will wear masks and will be instructed to use them appropriately. Campers will be required to wear a mask during indoor activities.
7. Staff members and children **must not attend** the program if they have COVID-19 symptoms. Before dropping the child off, parents must review the symptom screening questions.
8. If a child develops symptoms while at the program, the child will be isolated away from the other children. The parent/guardian will be notified to come and pick up the child immediately.
 - a. Parents of campers with symptoms will be asked to take the self-assessment test at home and not return to camp if necessary. Campers who are unable to return to their week of camp can be moved to a different week, provided there is space.

Parents/guardians will receive an email one week prior to the child's camp date which will include things to pack, instructions for dropping off and picking up children and any additional required forms.

These guidelines will be updated as needed to stay as up to date as possible.
